## 1. Introduction

Learn Anything Ltd (“we,” “our,” or “us”) is committed to protecting the privacy and security of the personal data we process. We act as a **data processor**, not a data controller, meaning we process data on behalf of educational institutions and teachers who determine the purposes and means of data use. This Data Sharing Policy outlines how we collect, use, store, and share data in compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

## 2. Scope and Purpose

This policy applies to all customer data, including information provided by teachers and students who use our services. We store and process personal data solely to facilitate educational assessments, provide feedback, and enhance the learning experience.

## 3. Data We Collect and Store

We store the following personal data in our secure, UK-based database located in London:

- **Teachers and Students:**
  - First Name
  - Surname
  - Email Address
  - School Name

We do not collect or process any sensitive personal data (as defined under UK GDPR).

## 4. Data Sharing with Third Parties

We share **student answers** (but no other personal data) with selected third-party AI providers for the purpose of automated marking and feedback. The companies we work with are:

#### 4.1 How We Share Data

- We **only share student answers** (not names, emails, or any other identifying information).
- These companies **do not store student answers** or use them to train their AI models.
- Data is transmitted securely using encryption protocols to protect privacy.

### 5. Legal Basis for Data Processing and Sharing

We process and share data under the following lawful bases under UK GDPR:

- **Contractual necessity** – Processing is required to provide our educational services.
- **Legitimate interest** – We use AI technology to improve marking efficiency and feedback quality, ensuring better learning outcomes for students.
- **Consent** – By using our platform, users agree to our terms, including the sharing of student answers with AI providers.

### 6. Data Security and Retention

- We implement robust security measures, including encryption, access controls, and regular security audits, to safeguard stored data.
- Personal data is stored on **secure servers within the UK (London)**.
- Student answers shared with AI providers are **not stored or retained** by them.
- We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for educational purposes and compliance with legal obligations.

## 7. Data Subject Rights

Under UK GDPR, individuals have the following rights regarding their data:

- **Right to access** – Request a copy of personal data we hold.
- **Right to rectification** – Correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- **Right to erasure (“Right to be forgotten”)** – Request deletion of personal data.
- **Right to restrict processing** – Limit how we use data in certain circumstances.
- **Right to object** – Object to data processing based on legitimate interests.
- **Right to data portability** – Request transfer of personal data to another service.
